An adoption contract must be signed when adopting a Fantastical Beasties' kitten/cat. The adoption contract is designed to protect the Adopting Family, the Breeder, and the welfare of the kitten/cat.

BREEDER OBLIGATIONS

- 1. The Breeder, Fantastical Beasties, provides a 72-hour limited health warranty that the above kitten/cat is in good health. The Breeder also warranties that prior to adoption, all kittens will be established on a deworming schedule as well as receive at least one vaccination for Feline Rhinotracheitis Virus/Herpesvirus 1 (FVR/FHV-1), Feline Calicivirus (FCV), and Feline Panleukopenia (FPV). Depending on availability, an additional Feline Leukemia (FeLV) vaccine may be administered. A copy of the kitten/cat's health record will be given to the Adopting Family at the time of adoption.
- 2. If the kitten/cat described above dies within one year of the date of adoption due to a congenital or hereditary defect, the Breeder will replace the kitten/cat with a kitten/cat of similar or better

quality or refund all or part of the adoption fee, at the sole discretion of the Breeder. To determine if a congenital or hereditary defect has caused the kitten/cat's death, the Breeder must receive proof of the defect in the form of a complete necropsy report, completed by a licensed veterinarian and performed at the Adopting Family's expense.

- 3. If the kitten/cat described above is found to have been neglected by the Adopting Family, in ill health, or if the Adopting Family does not abide by the terms of this adoption contract, the Adopting Family will surrender said kitten/cat to the Breeder unconditionally.
- 4. If applicable: If the Queen and Sire are registered, the Breeder will provide the Adopting Family with the kitten/cat's pedigree registration papers at the time of adoption or in a timely manner. The kitten/cat's registration fee is the responsibility and the option of the Adopting Family.

ADOPTING FAMILY OBLIGATIONS

- 1. To validate this warranty, the Adopting Family must take the kitten/cat to a veterinarian within 72 hours of adoption at the Adopting Family's expense. The Adopting Family must immediately notify the Breeder of any claim under this warranty. The Breeder must authorize any necessary treatment or other costs prior to treatment.
- 2. If at this first visit, the veterinarian finds any physical problems that make the kitten/cat a poor health risk, the veterinarian will note and explain their findings on their clinic's letterhead and provide this to the Breeder. The kitten/cat may then be returned to the Breeder within seven days for a full refund or exchange for a new kitten/cat of similar or better quality, if available. The Adopting Family will be responsible for all return transportation costs.
- 3. The Adopting Family agrees to provide the kitten/cat with a clean, pleasant environment and adequate space for exercise, all of which are conducive to good health. At least one litter box that will be cleaned daily will be provided for each pair of kittens/cats in the household. The kitten/cat will not be caged unless directed by a veterinarian for the kitten/cat's safety or health.
- 4. The Adopting Family will provide the kitten/cat, who are categorized as 'obligate carnivores,' with proper nutrition consisting primarily of animal-based protein-rich kitten/cat food, which is the diet directly advised by veterinarians, as well as ample fresh water daily.
- 5. The Adopting Family will provide the kitten/cat with proper veterinarian care, vaccines, and companionship. Any significant health conditions during the kitten/cat's lifetime will be reported to the Breeder promptly.
- 6. The Adopting Family agrees the kitten/cat will live indoors only.
- 7. The Adopting Family will not declaw the kitten/cat.

8. The Adopting Family will not, under any circumstances, give, sell, or lease the kitten/cat to any animal shelter, research facility, laboratory, pet store, or other commercial or noncommercial entities. If the Adopting Family can no longer keep the kitten/cat, the Breeder will be contacted immediately as the first option to assist in placing the animal.

LONG-TERM HEALTH CARE AND/OR LEGAL PROCEEDINGS

- 1. The Breeder will not be held liable for any veterinary or health care costs occurring while the kitten/cat is in possession of the Adopting Family, except as provided for and by the above limited warranty.
- 2. The Breeder's maximum liability to the Adopting Family for any and all losses, claims, damages, or liability of any kind shall be limited to the amount paid by the Adopting Family to the Breeder under this agreement. Any expenses for health care requested of the Breeder by the Adopting Family will be paid at the discretion of the Breeder.
- 3. If the Adopting Family fails to comply with any aspect of this agreement, the Adopting Family forfeits any rights the Adopting Family may otherwise have.
- 4. If legal proceedings become necessary, the Adopting family agrees that all legal and/or court procedures occur in the county where the Breeder resides. By signing below, the Adopting Family and the Breeder indicate that they have read and agree with all of the provisions of the above contract.
